About This Role:

Provide medical services to Lamar University student athletes under the direction of the Director of Sports Medicine and team physicians. Must have the ability to make independent decisions in the following areas: injury assessment, injury referrals, injury care management, return to play, emergency care, communication, and administration. This position requires the ability to work with the athletic training staff, strength and conditioning staff, sport coaches, athletic administration, team physicians, and various departments across campus. This position also serves as an adjunct instructor for the undergraduate introduction to athletic training program within the college of Kinesiology. This position may require you to work non-traditional hours, including early morning, evenings, weekends, and holidays. Some travel required. This job is not suitable for remote work.

Position Responsibilities:

- Assist team Physician and Director of Sports Medicine in injury recognition, treatment, rehabilitation, and conditioning of the student-athlete. Accurately maintain all records and reports (physical examinations, injury records, physician notes, treatment & rehabilitation notes, insurance claims, etc.).
- Serve as adjunct instructor in the college of Kinesiology (teach 1 class/year)
- Serve as a clinical preceptor for athletic training students.
- Assist in policy & procedure updates in accordance with NCAA recommendations.
- Assist with departmental inventory and supply ordering.
- Perform other duties as assigned by Director of Sports Medicine.

Minimum Qualifications

- Master's degree Athletic Training, or related field/concentration required.
- Minimum of one (1) year of experience as a certified Athletic Trainer providing health care for intercollegiate and/or professional athletes.
- Strong organization, administrative and communication skills.
